Why in News?

• On 1st July 2022 The Desert Corps of the Indian Army organised the "Suraksha Manthan 2022", on aspects of Border & Coastal Security at Jodhpur (Rajasthan).

- The Suraksha Manthan was jointly presided over by Shri Pankaj Kumar Singh, IPS, Director General Border Security Force (BSF), Director General VS Pathania, Indian Coast Guard and Lieutenant General Rakesh Kapoor, General Officer Commanding Desert Corps and attended by serving officers of the Army, BSF and Coast Guard.
- A joint training calendar was also formulated to achieve a higher degree of interoperability and
 jointness amongst the security forces. Current security threats and challenges, along with joint
 mitigation response, were deliberated upon and such scenarios would now form part of the
 forthcoming exercises.
- It was further decided to create an enabling security environment and develop a tangible capability development road map to achieve the same.

- 'Konark Corps' was raised on the auspicious day of Shivratri on 26 February 1987 under Lieutenant General A K Chatterjee, ParamVishishtSeva Medal, VishishtSeva Medal during Operation Trident.


DIGITAL INDIA WEEK 2022



Why in News?

From July 4th to 9th is celebrated as Digital India Week 2022, the event commemorated the pathbreaking journey of the flagship initiative of the Digital India Programme

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated Digital India Week 2022 at Mahatma Mandir in Gandhinagar, Gujarat.
- The theme of this year Digital India Week is 'Catalyzing New India's Techade' to transform the nation into a digitally empowered society and knowledge economy.
- The second day theme is 'Accelerating Start-up Economy.'





 During the Program Prime Minister launched various Schemes and Initiatives and Digital India Week 2022 also had a three-day long orientation program 'India Stack Knowledge Exchange-Showcasing India Stack and India's Digital Products and Service' from 7th July to 9th July 2022.

Digital India Programme?

- The Digital India Programme was launched on July 1, 2015 by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India with a vision to transform the country into a digitally empowered society and knowledge economy.
- Digital India is a flagship programme of the Government of India with a vision to transform India into a digitally empowered society and knowledge economy.
- Digital India is an umbrella programme that covers multiple Government Ministries and Departments

Digital Initiatives?

- 1. **Digital India GENESIS:** Digital India GENESIS (Gen-Next Support for Innovative Startups) a national Deep-tech Startup Platform by MeitY with an outlay of 750+ crores was launched by PM Shri Narendra Modi.
 - The platform envisages impacting and consolidating 10,000+ tech start-ups over the course of the next 5 years, especially from Tier-II & Tier III cities of India which will be equipped with the right tools and backed by a conducive infrastructure for starting and scaling up.
- 2. Meri Pehchaan: is National Single Sign On (NSSO) for One Citizen Login. It is a user authentication service in which a single set of credentials provide access to multiple online applications or services. This offers major benefits for both users and application administrators. It eliminates the need to repeatedly prove their identities to different applications and hold different credentials for each application and also helps identify the real applications as opposed to fake ones.
- 3. **Indiastack.global:** a global repository of key projects implemented under India Stack like Aadhaar, UPI, Digilocker, Cowin Vaccination Platform, Government e-Marketplace (GeM), DIKSHA Platform and Ayushman Bharat Digital Health Mission. This offering of India to the Global Public Digital Goods repository will help position India as the leader in building





Digital Transformation projects at a population scale and prove to be of immense help to other countries which are looking for such technology solutions.

- 4. **Digital India Bhashini:** will enable easy access to the internet and digital services in Indian languages, including voice-based access, and help the creation of content in Indian languages. The key intervention in building AI-based language technology solutions for Indian languages will be the creation of multilingual datasets. Digital India Bhashini will enable massive citizen engagement to build these datasets through a crowdsourcing initiative called BhashaDaan.
- 5. **MyScheme:** a service discovery platform facilitating access to Government Schemes. It aims to offer a one-stop search and discovery portal where users can find schemes that they are eligible for.
- 6. The chips to startups: The C2S Programme aims to train specialized manpower in the area of design of semiconductor chips at Bachelors, Masters and Research levels, and act as a catalyst for the growth of Startups involved in semiconductor design in the country. It offers to mentor at the organisational level and makes available State-of-the-art facilities for design to the institutions. This is part of the India Semiconductor Mission to build a strong design ecosystem in semiconductors.

- Yamuna, is one of the focus areas of Namami Gange Programme and informed that a 318
 MLD STP at Coronation Pillar has already been commissioned recently whereas 3 other main
 STPs on Yamuna funded by NMCG are targeted to be completed by December 2022

Namami Gange Programme?

- 'Namami Gange Programme', is an Integrated Conservation Mission, approved as 'Flagship Programme' by the Union Government in June 2014 with budget outlay of Rs.20,000 Crore to accomplish the twin objectives of effective abatement of pollution, conservation and rejuvenation of National River Ganga.
- Main pillars of the Namami Gange Programme are:
 - 1. Sewerage Treatment Infrastructure
 - 2. River Surface Cleaning
 - 3. Afforestation
 - 4. Industrial Effluent Monitoring
 - 5. Ganga Gram
 - 6. Public Awareness
 - 7. Bio-Diversity
 - 8. River front Development





LONGEST DOUBLE-DECKER BRIGDE



Why in News?

Recently, NHAI jointly with Maharashtra Metro achieved the world record for constructing the longest double-decker viaduct.

- The National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) and Maharashtra Metro achieved the world record for constructing the longest double-decker viaduct with a length of 3.14 km in Nagpur.
- Construction of Maximum Metro stations (3 Metro Stations) on Double Decker Viaduct in Nagpur, Recognized by Asia Book of Records & India Book of Records.
- The three metro stations built along this double-decker viaduct are Chattrapati chowk, Jayaprakash Nagar and Ujwal Nagar.
- NHAI has used RIB and spine techniques to build this viaduct.
- This double-decker viaduct made possible a three-layered transport corridor with the first layer occupied by pre-existing highway, the second layer by a flyover highway, and the third layer by Nagpur metro rail.
- The flyover highway is built at the height of nine metres, and the metro at 20 metres.
- While 2.7 km of this multi-layered corridor has a four-lane road on its second level, half km has a six-lane road.





- This project has led to savings on land acquisition and construction costs and also reduced the travel time to the airport from the earlier 30 minutes to mere 4 minutes.
- In February 2021, the union government allocated Rs 5,976 crore for Nagpur Metro Phase-II.
- The Nagpur Metro Rail Phase II Project, spread over 43.8 km in length with 32 stations, covers the rural parts of the Nagpur district and will serve as an extension to the ongoing first phase.

INDIA'S 1ST CARBON-NEUTRAL AIRPORT



- Indian Airports have now submitted the plan and keep monitoring environment friendly measures by December 2024 most Indian Airports will become carbon netural and achieve Net Zero Emission by 2030.
- The Airports Authority of India, Leh airport is being built as a carbon-neutral airport, a first in India.
- It is a "Geothermal system" in hybridization with Solar PV Plant will be provided in the New airport Terminal Building for heating and cooling purposes.
- This system works by exchanging heat between the air and the ground as its heat pumps are used for space heating and cooling, as well as water heating.
- The main feature of this process is that naturally existing heat is concentrated and used.
- It is estimated that 900 ton of carbon emissions per year will be reduced after adopting the "Geothermal system" at the Leh Airport Terminal Building project.





What is carbon Neutrality accreditation?

- Carbon neutrality means having a balance between emitting carbon and absorbing carbon from the atmosphere in carbon sinks.
- Airport Carbon and other Green House Gas Emission released into air when fossil fuels are used to generate electricity, in furnaces, and to power vehicles. CO2 makes up the majority of GHG emissions, with lesser contributions from nitrous oxide (N2O), methane (CH4), refrigerants, and other compounds.
- Ground-based airport GHG emissions are caused by gasoline and diesel fuel for airport vehicles and ground support equipment (GSE), fossil fuel for electricity and heating, jet fuel for auxiliary power units (APUs) that power aircraft at airport gates, and other sources that provide energy to planes at airport gates, and other sources.
- Around 2.1 per cent of all human-induced carbon dioxide emissions come from the aviation industry and it is responsible for 12 per cent of CO2 emissions from all modes of transportation.
- The Airports Council International has developed a carbon neutrality accreditation programme for airports that will help them cut carbon emissions.

"AADHAARFACERD"APP









KEY POINTS

- The Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) has launched a face authentication feature through a new mobile app called "AadhaarFaceRd". For authentication, Aadhaar card holders no longer need to physically visit an enrollment centre for iris and fingerprint scans.
- The UIDAI has started using face authentication as a method of confirming an Aadhaar holder's identity. Once your facial authentication is successful, it verifies your identity.
- This application enables secure capture of a live person image to perform Aadhaar face authentication.

Why "AADHAARFACERD" APP needed?

- Recently, the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) has canceled about 6 lakh fake Aadhaar cards.
- At the time of making the card, a 12-digit Aadhaar number is issued to the citizen, which in a way confirms his identity but every day, cases of illegal work being done by making fake Aadhar cards.
- Aadhaar Authentication is done by UIDAI and its authorized agency to verify whether your Aadhaar card is genuine or fake.
- For Aadhaar authentication, people have to go to the local Aadhaar Enrollment Center to scan their fingerprints and iris and match the entered biometric data with their Aadhaar number. Upon receipt of the data, the authentication process is completed.
- Now for the convenience of the general public, the authority has launched the AadhaarFaceRd app through this app, authentication work can be completed sitting at home or anywhere. Now it is not necessary to go to the center for this work.





INDIA'S FIRST E-WASTE ECO PARK



Why in News?

Delhi Environment Minister Gopal Rai announced to develop India's first e-waste eco park in Holambi Kalan in Delhi.

- Delhi Environment Minister Gopal Rai convened a joint review meeting with representatives from the Environment Department and the Delhi Pollution Control Committee.
- Approximately 21 acres would be used to create India's first e-waste eco park in Holambi Kalan, a neighbourhood of Delhi.
- Delhi environment department stated that every year the capital city produces over two lakh tonnes of e-waste, or about 9.5 percent of the total amount produced in India.
- With this, Delhi is now the fifth-largest producer of e-waste in India, behind Maharashtra,
 Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh, and West Bengal and it has been shown that only 5 per cent of the generated e-waste is properly recycled.
- Because of this delhi government decided to develop India's first e-waste eco park.
- e-waste eco park," refer to the establishment of a place where this e-waste is dismantled, refurbished, recycled, and manufactured in a manner that is scientifically and environmentally sound.
- The park will be ready in about 23 months







FIRST DIGITAL LOK ADALAT



- During the 18th All India Legal Services Authorities' convention, which was held here,
 NLSA Chairman Uday Umesh Lalit unveiled the first digital Lok Adalat driven by
 Artificial Intelligence and block chain technology
- Rajasthan State Legal Services Authority's (RSLSA) digital Lok Adalat was created by Jupitice Justice Technologies, the organization's technological partner.
- Digital Lok Adalat has facilitated claimants to attend the hearings and pre-counselling sessions from the comfort of their homes.
- The digital transformation of lok adalat makes it ergonomic, cost Effective, and time efficient for all stakeholders involved.



'SWANIRBHAR NAARI', A SCHEME



- Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma has launched 'Swanirbhar Naari', a scheme to empower indigenous weavers in Assam's Guwahati.
- This scheme will assist weavers to expand their businesses and support their families financially.
- It has been stated that there will be an online website that will enable them to sell their goods on an internet basis with no intermediaries so that they can get the full benefits.
- This scheme comes under the department of handloom textiles and sericulture to conserve the state's cultural heritage and promote people who have inherited this skill from their ancestors.
- The scheme enables the improvement of the rural economy via modern technology and inspiration by providing a good work culture and access to beneficial resources and by boosting the production of quality raw materials and completed products.
- A person who wants to avail the benefit of scheme needs to be an Assamese resident only and recipient must be a weaver.
- This scheme will be very beneficial for 4 lakh families in 1st phase economically disadvantaged women who are working with full dedication and sincerity.
- The main aim of this scheme is to create more than 3.72 lack sustainable individual and 822 community assets to provide benefit to those who are giving their 100% to improve their financial condition.
- This scheme would be implemented under MGNREGA to complete the various missions.





HAR GHAR TIRANGA



KEY POINTS

- Har Ghar Tiranga Campaign is a campaign under the Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav to celebrate the 75th independence Day by bringing National Flag home and hoisting it.
- By urging all citizens to fly the national flag at their homes between August 13 and 15.
- The flag of the country has been changed six times in the last 116 years. However, these changes took place only till independence.
- The last change in the Indian national flag was in 1947, at which time it was also given the name of Tricolor.

JOURNEY OF INDIAN FLAG





- The first national flag received in 1906: The country's first proposed flag appeared in 1906 which was hoisted on August 7, 1906 at Parsi Bagan Chowk, Calcutta (now Green Park, Kolkata). This flag had three stripes green, yellow and red. It had eight lotus flowers in the upper green stripe, which were white in colour. Vande Mataram was written in blue in the yellow stripe in the middle. Apart from this, the pictures of the moon and the sun were painted in white in the red stripe at the bottom.
- The flag was changed the very next year in 1907: Madam Bhikajikama and some of her revolutionary companions, together raised the new flag of India in Paris by making some changes to the first flag. This flag was also very similar in appearance to the previous one. But it had three stripes of saffron, yellow and green. Vande Mataram was written in the middle. At the same time, eight stars were also formed along with the moon and the sun.
- Annie Besant and Tilak hoisted the new flag 1917: In 1917 another new flag was proposed for the country. This new flag was hoisted by Dr. Annie Besant and Lokmanya Tilak. This new flag, proposed in the third time, had five red and four green stripes. Towards the end of the flag, there was a triangular shape in black color. At the same time, there was also a Union Jack in the left corner. Whereas along with a moon and a star, it also included seven stars representing the Saptarishi.
- 1921 Proposed flag for India: All India Congress Committee in 1921, a man from Andhra Pradesh at Bezwada (now Vijayawada) presented a flag to Mahatma Gandhi, it was green and It was red. Gandhiji liked it and made some changes in it. He added another white stripe to it. At the same time, a spinning wheel was also shown in the middle to show the development of the country. Then somewhere it was accepted for the flag of independent India.
- 1931, the proposed national flag: In 1931 to identify independent India. The newly proposed flag had a saffron color at the top, white in the middle and a green stripe at the end. In this, the whole spinning wheel was also shown in small size in the middle white strip. The spinning wheel in the white band was said to be a symbol of the progress of the nation. This new flag was officially adopted by the Indian National Congress.
- The country finally got the tricolor in 1947: The flag made in 1931 was adopted as the new national flag of independent India in the Constituent Assembly meeting on July 22, 1947, with one





change. In this flag, instead of the spinning wheel, the Dharma Chakra of Maurya Emperor Ashoka is shown in dark blue color. The wheel of 24 spokes is also called the wheel of the method. This flag was designed by Pingali Venkaiah. It has a saffron stripe on top, white in the middle and a green stripe below. All three are in proportion. Its length and breadth are two times three.

SECOND BHARAT GAURAV TRAIN



Why in News?

Recently, IRCTC announces second run of Bharat Gaurav Train flagged off from Madurai to Varanasi.

- The second Bharat Gaurav train in Southern Railway left Madurai with 170 passengers for Varanasi a 12-day pilgrimage to several places, including seven Sakthi Peeth.
- The 12-day Bharat Gaurav round trip Service from Madurai to Varanasi will run via Dindigul, Tiruchchirappalli, Villupuram, Chennai Egmore, Vijayawada, Samalkote, Puri, Jaipur, Howrah, Gaya to reach Varanasi and return to Madurai via Prayagraj Rambagh, Ballarshah, Warrangal and Vijayawada.
- The train will run with a composition of of Four 3AC coaches, Six Sleeper class coaches, 2 pantry cars and 2 SLRs.



Bharat Gaurav Trains

- With the objective of showcasing India's rich cultural heritage and magnificent historical places to the people of India and the world, Indian Railways introduced the "Bharat Gaurav Trains" scheme with effect from 23.11.2021.
- The first service of the theme-based Bharat Gaurav Train from Coimbatore North to Sainagar Shirdi was operated on 14.06.2022.
- Bharat Gaurav scheme also aims to leverage the core strengths of the professionals of the tourism sector to run theme-based trains to tap the vast tourist potential of India
- This scheme allows private players to operate trains on theme-based circuits.

INTERNATION ISSUES

BIMSTEC EXPERT GROUP



KEY POINTS

- The National Security Council Secretariat, Government of India is organizing a two day Meeting of the BIMSTEC Expert Group on Cyber Security Cooperation on 14-15 July 2022 in New Delhi
- The Meeting is based on the agreement made during the meeting of the BIMSTEC National Security Chiefs held at Bangkok in March 2019 that the BIMSTEC Expert Group will formulate an Action plan to deal with Cyber Security challenges in the BIMSTEC Region.
- The in-person meeting is being chaired by the National Cyber Security Coordinator Lt General Rajesh Pant and witness the participation of delegates from Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Myanmar, Nepal, Sri Lanka and Thailand. All the delegates are experts in Cyber Security from their respective Government organization.

BIMSTEC?

• BIMSTEC organizes inter-governmental interactions through Summits, Ministerial Meetings, Senior Officials Meetings and Expert Group Meetings and through BIMSTEC Working Group (BWG) based in Bangkok.





- Bay of Bengal Initiative for Multi-Sectoral Technical and Economic Cooperation
 (BIMSTEC) comprising Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Myanmar, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Thailand
 brings together 1.5 billion people 21% of the world population, and a combined GDP of
 over US\$ 2.5 trillion.
- The Bay of Bengal Initiative for Multi-Sectoral Technical and Economic Cooperation (BIMSTEC) is a regional organization that was established on 06 June 1997 with the signing of the Bangkok Declaration. Initially known as BIST-EC (Bangladesh-India-Sri Lanka-Thailand Economic Cooperation), the organisation is now known as BIMSTEC and comprises seven Member States with the admission of Myanmar on 22 December 1997, and Bhutan and Nepal in February 2004.
- Being a sector-driven grouping, cooperation within BIMSTEC had initially focused on six sectors in 1997 (trade, technology, energy, transport, tourism, and fisheries) and expanded in 2008 to incorporate agriculture, public health, poverty alleviation, counter-terrorism, environment, culture, people-to-people contact, and climate change.

Why in News?

KEY POINTS

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi unveiled a 30-feet bronze statue of Alluri Sitarama Raju at Bhimavaram in Andhra Pradesh's East Godavari district on his 125th birth Anniversary.
- The 15-tonne statue was carved out at a cost of Rs 3 crore and installed by the Kshatriya Seva Samiti in the Municipal Park in Bhimavaram.
- Allure Sitarama Raju is an inspiration and a symbol of bravery and courage of tribals.
- Sitarama Raju, also referred to by his surname Alluri, was born on July 4, 1897, at Pandrangi village in the then Visakhapatnam district

- Manish Sisodia, the deputy chief minister of Delhi, started Mission Kushal Karmi to help construction workers improve their abilities.
- Delhi government developed this programme with assistance from the Delhi Skill and Entrepreneurship University (DSEU) and Delhi Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Board.
- Under this 15 days special training programme, workers will undergo upskilling which will boost their incomes in future."
- "This will help in increasing the income of workers up to Rs 8,000. The government aims to train 2 lakh workers in a year under this programme. Construction companies will also benefit from these skilled workers.
- During the training, all the construction workers will be provided with an amount of Rs 4,200 each.

Benefits to Workers from Mission Kushal Karmi:

- Wage loss compensation of Rs. 4,200 (Rs 35 per hour of training) to each construction worker after completion of training.
- Improvement in income ranging upto 8,000 per month after completion of training to construction workers.
- Increase in productivity of workers by 40 per cent, increase quality of product produced by 25 per cent and wastage of materials decreases by 50 per cent.

- Improvement in the understanding of standard safety norms thereby increasing the longevity of work and social security.

'SVANIDHI MAHOTSAV'

- The festival was organized in 75 cities across all states and Union Territories, and showcase various cultural activities, digital training activities and loan melas.
- It also have functions for felicitation of distinguished Street vendors.
- PM SVANidhi scheme was launched on June 1, 2020 to facilitate working capital loans to the street vendors to help them restart their businesses which were adversely impacted due to the lockdowns imposed during COVID-19 pandemic.
- The scheme facilitates collateral free working capital loan upto Rs 10000 of 1 year tenure with enhanced loan of Rs 20000 and 50000 in the second and third term respecticely on repayment of earlier loans, to enable business expansion.
- The scheme incentivizes adoption of digital transactions by way of cashback of upto Rs 100





per month which in turn would build their credit profile facilitating future loans from the lending institutions.

• Till date more than 25 lakh sanctions have been made under these schemes facilitating socio economic upliftment of more than 11 lakh beneficiaries and family members

- The main objective of the scheme is to develop a student as a multifaceted personality with academic excellence and a commitment to an egalitarian society
- 'Earn with Learn' Scheme was bring back those who had dropped out of schools following the outbreak of Covid-19 Pandemic.
- This scheme is a part of the 'Vidyalaya Chalo Abhiyan' (Let's go to school). The Government attempted to bring back dropouts in 2020 by implementing the Vidyalaya Chalo Abhiyan, which was first started in 2009 but was unable to make any progress due to the pandemic.
- About 8,000 students between the age group of six and 14 had dropped out of school during the pandemic and have not yet returned.
- This scheme aims at bring them back to school.
- Under this 3rd year college students will make efforts to track down the drop-outs.
- And the college students who are willing to participate as volunteer government would pay 500 Rs per Admission for each college student.
- Approx 10000 volunteers are required for implementation of this innovative scheme.
- For this Anganwadi and ASHA workers will also engaged and they will be given 200 Rs per child.

KEY POINTS

- 'Dunagiri' is the fourth ship under P17A project. The P17A Frigates are being equipped with improved stealth features, advanced weapons and sensors and platform management systems.
- The first two ships under P17A Project, were launched in 2019 and 2020 at Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited (MDL) and GRSE respectively. The 3rd ship (Udaygiri) was launched at MDL in May this year.
- The Project 17A project involves the development of seven advanced guided-missile frigates, of which four will be built by Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders and the remaining three ships by GRSE.
- The ships will be named Nilgiri, Himgiri, Udaygiri, Dunagiri, Taragiri, Vindhyagiri and Mahendragiri after the names of hill ranges in India.

PRADHAN MANTRI VAYA VANDANA YOJANA



Why in News?

• The five years of the Pradhan Mantri Vaya Vandana Yojana are now complete. 21 July, 2017 marked the official launch of the programme.

KEY POINTS

• The programme is a social security programme for the elderly that aims to provide them with a guaranteed minimum pension based on a guaranteed return on the purchase price or subscription fee.





- The minimum investment required to participate in this scheme has been increased to one lakh 56 thousand 658 rupees for a pension of 12,000 per year and to one lakh 62 thousand 162 rupees for a pension of at least 1,000 rupees per month.
- The programme, which was in place through 2020, has now been extended for an additional three years, through March 31, 2023.

Pradhan Mantri Vaya Vandana Yojana

- Pradhan Mantri Vaya Vandana Yojana (PMVVY) is a Pension Scheme announced by the Government of India exclusively for the senior citizens aged 60 years and above which was available from 4th May, 2017 to 31st March, 2020.
- The scheme is now extended up to 31st March 2023 for a further period of three years beyond 31st March 2020.
- Under the scheme the pensioner will receive an assured return of 8% for the policy duration of 10 Years.
- The purchase price will be paid back to the beneficiary if the pensioner passes away during the policy tenure.
- If the pensioner survives the entire policy tenure, the purchase price will be paid along with the final pension instalment.

PROJECT SURYA









- Under project surya initiatve women salt pan workers who work in the challenging and extreme temperatures at Rann of kutch marshes will be trained as solar panel and solar pump technicians
- Green energy firm ReNew Power has partnered with United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) and Self-Employed Women's Association of India (SEWA) to train 1,000 low-income women salt-pan workers to work in the renewable industry.
- ReNew is providing financial support and familiarization with its renewable facility in the
 area, while SEWA is the lead implementation partner, UNEP will be responsible for
 monitoring and evaluating the project
- At present, these women are able to save an average of Rs 10,000 (USD 128) in around 10 months, while a solar panel technician can earn up to Rs 18,000 (USD 130) in a month.

U20 ASIAN WRESTLING CHAMPIONSHIPS




KEY POINTS

- PM Modi was joined by United States President Joe Biden, Israeli PM Yair Lapid and UAE
 President Mohammed bin Zayed Al Nahyan.
- "The leaders discussed the possible joint projects within the framework of 'I2U2' as well as the
 other common areas of mutual interest to strengthen the economic partnership in trade and
 investment in our respective regions and beyond.



SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

ABHYAS: HIGH-SPEED EXPENDABLE AERIAL TARGET



- Recently, India successfully tested the indigenously-designed Abhyas a High-speed Expendable Aerial Target (HEAT) in Odisha.
- The trial was carried out by the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) from the Integrated Test Range (ITR) in Odisha's Chandipur.
- The performance of the aircraft at low altitude including sustained level and high manoeuvrability was demonstrated during the test flight.
- The target aircraft was flown from a ground based controller in a pre-designated low altitude flight path, which was monitored by various tracking sensors deployed by ITR, including radar and electro-optical targeting system.
- ABHYAS is designed & developed by Aeronautical Development Establishment of Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO).



PSLV-C53



- The Indian Space Research Organisation on Thursday successfully launched PSLV-C53 which placed three Singapore satellites in orbits.
- The fourth stage of the rocket then turned into an orbital platform for scientific experiments as it began to circle the Earth.
- This is the 55th mission of PSLV and the 15th mission using the PSLV-Core Alone variant. It is the 16th PSLV launch from the second launch pad.
- The mission proposes to demonstrate the utilization of the spent upper stage of the launch vehicle as a stabilized platform for scientific payloads subsequent to the separation of the satellites.





INDIA'S FIRST-EVER FACTORY TO MANUFACTURE 3D-PRINTED ROCKET ENGINES



KEY POINTS

- Space tech startup, Agnikul Cosmos has inaugurated India's first-ever factory to manufacture 3D-printed rocket engines in Chennai.
- The facility will use additive manufacturing technology to build 3D printed rocket engines and will be used to produce engines for its own in-house rockets.
- It was unveiled by Tata Sons chairman N Chandrasekaran and ISRO chairman S Somanath in the presence of Pawan Goenka, the chairman of IN-SPACe (Indian National Space Promotion and Authorization Centre).

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi has launched the 'India International Bullion Exchange (IIBX)', at the Gujarat International Finance Tec-City (GIFT City) near Gandhinagar, Gujarat.
- This exchange facilitate efficient price discovery with the assurance of responsible sourcing and quality, apart from giving impetus to the financialisation of gold in India.
- India's global bullion exchange, the IIBX will facilitate efficient price discovery and ensure





standardisation, quality assurance and sourcing integrity. Until now, only certain banks and nominated agencies were allowed by the Reserve Bank of India to import gold and sell it to dealers and jewellers.

• The prime minister also laid the foundation stone for the headquarters building of the International Financial Services Centres Authority.

GLOBAL GENDER GAP INDEX 2022

- This requires building a robust system for procurement, supply chain management and
 monitoring that ensures complete transparency, standardized process, sustainability, full
 coverage, leverages local ties, foster a culture of collaboration and builds trust within a
 community.
- These measures improve THR access in rural areas, produce THR with high nutrient value, enhance community ownership involving SHGs and promote income generating activities and female empowerment.

- World Food Program is the world's largest humanitarian organization, saving lives in emergencies and using food assistance to build a pathway to peace, stability and prosperity for people recovering from conflict, disasters and the impact of climate change.

'YOUTH IN INDIA 2022' REPORT



- According to a report titled Youth in India 2022, released by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI), by the year 2036, those above the age of 30 will form the majority of the country's population.
- The states of Bihar and Uttar Pradesh, which experienced a rise in proportion of youth population to total population till 2021, are expected to see a decline from hereon.
- These two states along with Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan are projected to have over half around 52% of country's youth.
- India's favourable demographic dividend is at an inflection point of sorts, with the population share of the youth starting to taper off even as the share of the elderly is expected to steadily surge during 2021-2036.
- Kerala, Tamil Nadu and Himachal Pradesh are projected to see a higher elderly population than the youth by 2036.
- Proportion of youth to total population of the country had increased from 26.6% in 1991 to





- 27.9% in 2016 and then declined, and would reach 22.7% by 2036, according to the 'Youth in India 2022' report.
- As per to the recently released United Nations world Population Prospects(WPP) 2022, India is projected to surpass china as the world most populous country in 2023.

"ZERO COUPON ZERO PRINCIPAL INSTRUMENTS"



Why in News?

- The government has designated "zero coupon zero principal instruments" as securities in preparation for the creation of a social stock exchange.
- The instruments will be governed by rules made by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI).
- Declaration of zero coupon zero principal instruments as securities under the securities contracts (Regulation) Act, 1956.
- It means an instrument issued by a Not for Profit Organisation (NPO) which will be registered with the social stock exchange segment of a recognised stock exchange.

47TH GST COUNCIL MEETING







- The 47th GST Council met under the Chairmanship of Union Minister for Finance & Corporate Affairs Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman in Chandigarh.
- The meeting was attended by Union Minister of State for Finance Shri Pankaj Choudhary besides Finance Ministers of States & UTs and senior officers of the Ministry of Finance & States/ UTs.
- In case of Cheques, lose or in book form, Maps and hydrographic or similar charts of all kinds, including atlases, wall maps, topographical plans and globes, printed and Parts of goods of heading 8801 exemption from GST will be withdrawn.
- Exemption on transport of passengers by air to and from NE states & Bagdogra is being restricted to economy class.
- Exemption on transportation by rail or a vessel of railway equipment and material, storage or
 warehousing of commodities which attract tax (nuts, spices, copra, jaggery, cotton etc.),
 Services by RBI,IRDA,SEBI,FSSAI, Fumigation in a warehouse of agricultural produce,
 GSTN, Services provided by the cord blood banks by way of preservation of stem cells, and
 Renting of residential dwelling to business entities (registered persons) is being withdrawn.
- Hotel accommodation priced upto Rs. 1000/day shall be taxed at 12%, Room rent (excluding ICU) exceeding Rs 5000 per day per patient charged by a hospital shall be taxed to the extent of amount charged for the room at 5% without ITC and Tax exemption on training or coaching in recreational activities relating to arts or culture, or sports is being restricted to such services when supplied by an individual.
- The GST rates have been increased for services supplied by a foreman in a chit fund, jobs related to leather goods and footwear, processing of hides and skins, manufacturing of clay bricks, contracts for roads, bridges, railways, metro among others.





BUSINESS REFORMS ACTION PLAN (BRAP)



- Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, Haryana, Karnataka, Punjab, Tamil Nadu and Telangana are among
 the seven states that have been classified as "top achievers" in rolling out the Business Reforms
 Action Plan (BRAP) for 2020 the 5th edition of the BRAP exercise released by finance minister
 Nirmala Sitharaman, set by the department for the promotion of industry and internal trade
 (DPIIT).
- Himachal Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Odisha, Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh figure under the Achievers category.
- Assam, Chhattisgarh, Goa, Jharkhand, Kerala, Rajasthan and West Bengal have been placed in the Aspirers category
- Andaman & Nicobar, Bihar, Chandigarh, Daman & Diu, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Delhi, Jammu & Kashmir, Manipur, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Puducherry and Tripura have been clubbed under the Emerging Business Ecosystems category.
- The BRAP report comprises of 301 reform points, covering 15 business regulatory areas like
 access to Information, labour, single window system, sectoral reforms, environment, and other
 reforms related to lifecycle of a typical business. In it, sectoral reforms have been introduced
 for the first time.
- 118 new reforms were included to further augment the reform process. Sectoral reforms with 72 action points spread across 9 sectors namely Trade License, Healthcare, Legal Metrology, Cinema Halls, Hospitality, Fire NOC, Telecom, Movie Shooting and Tourism were introduced for the first time to expand the scope of reform agenda.

- The President is the principal spokesperson for the FATF and represents the FATF externally.
- The Financial Action Task Force is an Inter-Governmental body established in 1989 during the G7 Summit in Paris.





- Its secretariat is located at the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development headquarters in Paris.
- The objectives of the FATF are to set standards and promote effective implementation of legal, regulatory and operational measures for combating money laundering, terrorist financing and other related threats to the integrity of the international financial system.


14TH PRIME MINISTER OF ISRAEL

Analog Astronaut Training Centre:

- Analog Astronaut Training Centre is a private company, which accelerates human spaceflight scientific studies.
- AATC was created by former European Space Agency professionals: engineer and scientist.
- In 2018, the company established a laboratory to simulate space environment for scientific experiments focused on space biology and medicine.
- It is located in Rzepiennik, South of Poland.
- In 2021 the company has reached 32 successfully organized analog simulations, what positions Poland on the top in Europe considering the number of organized expeditions.



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National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA)

- The National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) is an independent agency of the US federal government responsible for the civil space program, aeronautics research and space research.
- NASA was established in 1958, succeeding the National Advisory Committee for Aeronautics (NACA).
- NASA headquarters at Washington, D.C., United States.

15TH PRESIDENT OF INDIA



- Daughter of a tribal family coming from a very ordinary house in Odisha, Draupadi Murmu has been elected as the 15th President of India.
- She is the ex-Jharkhand Governor, veteran politician from odisha, and she is the second woman after Pratibha Patil to hold the top office.
- Patil. Pratibha Patil served as the 12th President of the country from 25 July 2007 to 25 July 2012.
- The term of the incumbent President Ram Nath Kovind ends on July 24, Draupadi Murmu sworn in as the President of India on July 25, 2022.
- She belongs to Santhal tribe



Santhal tribe

- President Murmu was born into a Santhali family.
- Santhals are one of the largest tribes mostly settled in West Bengal, Odisha and Jharkhand. They also live in Bihar and Assam.
- Their official language is Santhali.
- Few other notable people from the Santhali community are Babulal Marandi, Hemant Soren, Shibu Soren and Raghunath Murmu.

Political career:

- In 1997, Droupadi Murmu was elected as the councillor of the Rairangpur Nagar Panchayat as an independent candidate from a reserved seat for women. She then joined the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP).
- She won the 2000 Odisha Legislative Assembly election from Rairangpur Assembly constituency and served two terms in the Odisha Legislative Assembly between 2000 and 2009.
- During the BJP and BJD coalition government in Odisha, she was the Minister of State with Independent Charge for Commerce and Transportation from 6 March 2000 to 6 August 2002, and Fisheries and Animal Resources Development from 6 August 2002 to 16 May 2004.
- In 2007, she received the Nilkanth Award for the Best MLA of the Odisha Legislative Assembly.
- In 2009, she lost the Lok Sabha election from Mayurbhanj Lok Sabha constituency as the BJD and BJP alliance had ended.
- She was elected to the BJP National Executive (ST Morcha) in 2013, and was the district president till 2015.
- Murmu was sworn in as the Governor of Jharkhand on 18 May 2015, becoming the first woman to hold the position.
- The BJP was in power in the Jharkhand Government for most of her six-year tenure as a governor and was also in power in the Union Government throughout her tenure.
- Her six-year tenure as Governor began in May 2015 and ended in July 2021





IMPORTANT DAYS

CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS DAY



- CA Day is a celebration of the foundation of Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) annually on 1st July.
- In India for accounting and auditing professions, the ICAI is the only licensing and regulatory body.

What is ICAI?

- The ICAI was set up by an Act of the Parliament to regulate the profession of chartered accountancy in the country. ICAI, which functions under the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India, is the second-largest professional chartered accountants' body in the world.
- In India, the ICAI is the sole body for the licensing and regulation of the financial audits and accounting profession in India. It is also one of the oldest professional institutes in the country.
- The body is managed in by a council comprising 40 members, in accordance with the provisions of the Chartered Accountants Act, 1949 and the Chartered Accountants Regulations, 1988. Thirty two members of the council are elected by the chartered accountants while the remaining eight members are nominated by the central government.



NATIONAL DOCTOR'S DAY



KEY POINTS

- India celebrates July 1 as 'National Doctor's Day' commemorating the iconic and internationally renowned medical practitioner, Dr Bidhan Chandra Roy who served as a physician, a freedom fighter, an educationist and a politician.
- The day, commemorated by Indian Medical Association (IMA), celebrates all doctors and healthcare workers who have been tirelessly serving people by risking their own lives.
- The theme this year is 'Family doctors on the front line.'

Who is Dr Bidhan Chandra?

Dr Bidhan Roy was also a prominent freedom fighter. The Bharat Ratna recipient established many medical institutes such as the Jadavpur T.B. Hospital, Kamala Nehru Memorial Hospital, Chittaranjan Cancer Hospital and the Chittaranjan Seva Sadan for women and children.

WORLD SPORTS JOURNALISTS DAY





- INCOME TAX DAY 2022: The Income Tax Day or Aaykar Diwas was introduced in 2010 to commemorate 150 years of this tax in India.






WORLD DROWNING PREVENTION DAY

EARTH OVERSHOOT DAY



Sol: G-secs, or government securities or government bonds, are instruments that governments use to borrow money. G-secs carry the lowest risk of all investments. G-sec yields change over time; often several times during a single day. This happens because of the manner in which G-secs are structured. Every G-sec has a





face value, a coupon payment and price. The price of the bond may or may not be equal to the face value of the bond.

Here's an example: Suppose the government floats a 10-year G-sec with a face value of Rs 100 and a coupon payment of Rs 5. If one were to buy this single G-sec from the government, it would mean that one will give Rs 100 to the government today and the government will promises to 1) return the sum of Rs 100 at the end of tenure (10 years), and 2) pay Rs 5 each year until the end of this tenure. At this point, the face value of this G-sec is equal to its price, and its yield (or the effective interest rate) is 5%.

G-secs are the safest investments in any economy, and the G-sec yield is the lowest risk-free interest rate in any economy. As such, they are a good way to figure out the broader trend of interest rates in the economy. If G-sec yields (say for a 10-year bond) are going up, it would imply that lenders are demanding even more from private sector firms or individuals; that's because anyone else is riskier when compared to the government.





The facility will use additive manufacturing technology to build 3D printed rocket engines and will be used to produce engines for its own in-house rockets. It was unveiled by Tata Sons chairman N Chandrasekaran and ISRO chairman S Somanath in the presence of Pawan Goenka, the chairman of IN-SPACe (Indian National Space Promotion and Authorization Centre).

The company facility will use additive manufacturing technology to build 3D printed rocket engines and will be used to produce engines for its own in-house rockets. This will allow the factory to produce eight engines every month and build the number of engines required to launch Agnibaan – its two-stage launch vehicle, expected to launch by the end of the year. Agnikul was founded in 2017 by Srinath Ravichandran, Moin SPM and SR Chakravarthy (professor of IIT-Madras).
