POLICY OF GOVERNANCE

NATURAL ARCH DISCOVERED LOCATED IN THE KANIKA RANGE



Why in News?

Recently, The Geological Survey of India (GSI) plans to declare the 'Brahmani Natural Arch' in Kanika range of Sundargarh forest division of Odisha as a Geo Heritage Site.

- This natural arch is believed to date back to the Jurassic period and would be the largest natural arch in India with the Geo Heritage tag.
- The site showcases primary sedimentary structures and is believed to have formed due to fault activities and sub-aerial weathering.
- Apart from the arch at Sundargarh, India has two others-one at Tirumala hills in Tirupati and another at Andaman and Nicobar.
- Both are smaller as compared to Brahmani Natural Arch in Kanika range, Sundargarh.

PRADHAN MANTRI KRISHI SINCHAYEE YOJANA

- Centrally sponsored scheme Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY) was launched during the year 2015-16, with an aim to enhance physical access of water on farm and expand cultivable area under assured irrigation, improve on-farm water use efficiency, introduce sustainable water conservation practices, etc.
- PMKSY is an umbrella scheme, consisting, inter alia, of two major components being implemented by the Ministry of Jal Shakti, namely, Accelerated Irrigation Benefit Programme (AIBP), and Har Khet Ko Pani (HKKP).
- HKKP, in turn, consists of four sub-components: Command Area Development & Water Management (CAD&WM), Surface Minor Irrigation (SMI), Repair, Renovation and Restoration (RRR) of Water Bodies, and Ground Water (GW) Development. However, GW Development component was provisionally approved till March, 2022 only.
- PMKSY has Watershed Development (WD) component which is implemented by Department of Land Resources. Further, during the period 2015-22, Per Drop More Crop (PDMC) component was also being implemented under PMKSY by the Department of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare.



"MERI MATI MERA DESH" CAMPAIGN

KEY POINTS

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi announced the launch of "Meri Mati Mera Desh" campaign in runup to Independence Day to honor the martyred bravehearts of the country.
- During the campaign of Meri Mati Mera Desh an Amrit Kalash Yatra will also be taken out.
- This yatra will reach Delhi carrying the soil in 7,500 Kalash from villages and various corners of the country and also carry plants from various parts of the country.
- An 'Amrit Vatika' will be built close to the National War Memorial from these 7,500 Kalash of soil and plants.

ATAL BEEMIT VYAKTI KALYAN YOJANA



- The Government has decided to extend the Atal Beemit Vyakti Kalyan Yojana for an additional two years, continuing until June 30, 2024.
- This scheme is a welfare measure for employees covered under Section 2(9) of ESI Act, 1948, in the form of relief payment up to 90 days, once in a lifetime. The Scheme was introduced w.e.f. 01-





07-2018 on pilot basis for a period of two years initially.

• Under this scheme, eligible beneficiaries receive relief equal to 50% of their average per day earnings from the preceding four contribution periods. This is calculated as the total earning during those four periods divided by 730.

MISSION SHAKTI SCOOTER YOJANA



- Odisha Cabinet authorized the new "Mission Shakti Scooter Yojana" program.
- With this access to scooters will be made easier for Community Support Staff (CSS) and EC (Executive Committee) members of SHG federations.
- This program will provide qualified persons with full interest subvention on bank loans up to Rs 1 lakh for the purchase of a scooter of their choosing.
- It will empower them to fulfill their responsibilities more efficiently, thus increasing their effectiveness and extending their outreach within the community.
- This scheme is expected to benefit roughly 75,000 community support staff members of SHGs (Self Help Groups) and approximately 1,25,000 federation leaders associated with SHGs.



"UREA GOLD"

KEY POINTS

- PM Modi during his visit in Rajasthan launched a new type of Urea called "Urea Gold" which is coated with sulphur that can help improve the soil quality and reduce the expenses of the farmers.
- Urea Gold is a new fertilizer for Indian farmers that promises to address sulphur deficiency in the soil, reduce fertilizer consumption, improve nitrogen use efficiency, and enhance crop quality.
- As a result plants maintain their greenness for an extended duration.
- It is a product of innovation and vision that reflects the government's commitment to the welfare and prosperity of farmers.

'CHIEF MINISTER'S COMMAND CENTRE'



- Uttar Pradesh CM Yogi Adityanath launched Command Centre and CM Dashboard to ensure needy and deserving have access to the benefits of the government schemes and services.
- With the help of the Command Centre and Dashboard, the performance of officials working in the police service, municipal corporations, and development authorities, and the implementation of



various government schemes, will be evaluated through monthly rankings and grades.

- "Currently, 588 schemes of 53 departments are registered.
- A performance index has been developed based on the information received from departments on the CM Dashboard, and accordingly, monthly state-level grading will be issued.

A Data Quality Index has been developed to ensure the quality of departmental data, and its monthly evaluation will also be displayed.

MUKHYAMANTRI KHET SURAKSHA YOJANA



- The Uttar Pradesh government is all set to launch the Mukhyamantri Khet Suraksha Yojana across the state, with the primary objective of protecting crops from stray animals.
- On July 21,2023, for the welfare of the farmers of Uttar Pradesh, the UP Government launched Mukhyamantri Khet Suraksha Yojana.
- Under this scheme, farmers will be able to install solar fencing around their farms to prevent their crops from getting damaged by animals.
- This fence will have a 12 volt of current. Therefore, it will not harm animals but only shock them.
- There will also be a sound alarm that will restrict the wild animals such as Monkey, Pig and Nilgai to damage the crop in the farm.
- It should be noted that this scheme has been launched exclusively for small and marginal farmers.
- Therefore the financial assistance for the solar fencing will be available only to them. Through Mukhyamantri Khet Suraksha Yojana, the government seeks to empower farmers and help them to safeguard their crops from getting damaged.
- The UP Government has increased the budget for Mukhyamantri Khet Suraksha Yojana from Rs 75 Crore to 350 Crore (5 times) in order to provide the benefit of the scheme to every small and marginal farmer.



INDIA'S FIRST ATAL INCUBATION CENTRE (AIC) IN FISHERIES


SEMICON INDIA 2023

- India-Myanmar-Thailand Trilateral Highway (IMT Highway), 1,360 km long route, is a highway under construction under India's Look East policy that will connect Moreh, India with Mae Sot, Thailand via Myanmar.
- The construction work of this highway began in 2012 and is being implemented in several phases.
- India also plans to add a new connection to the IMT highway by upgrading the route from Zokhawthar in Mizoram to Tedim in the Chin state of Myanmar.

ASIAN KABADDI CHAMPIONSHIP 2023



- The Asian Kabaddi Championship 2023 concluded in Busan, Republic of Korea, with India beating Iran in the final to lift the title.
- The Indian men's kabaddi team won the title, beating Iran in the final. Know the results, scores from all matches and the full points table.
- Six teams India, Iran, Japan, Korea, Chinese Taipei and Hong Kong participated in the Asian Kabaddi Championships.
- In the final of the Asian Kabaddi Championship 2023 held at the Dong-Eui Institute of Technology Seokdang Cultural Center in Busan, Republic of Korea, India emerged victorious, defeating Iran with a score of 42-32. This marked India's eighth championship title in the past nine editions.



LAUSANNE DIAMOND LEAGUE 2023

WORLD AQUATICS CHAMPIONSHIPS





- The 2023 World Aquatics Championships, the 20th edition of the World Aquatics Championships, were held in Fukuoka, Japan, from 14 to 30 July 2023.
- It was the second time Fukuoka hosted the event having previously held the 9th World Aquatics Championships in 2001.
- The championships included 2,392 athletes competing from 192 member federations.

JUNIOR ASIAN JUDO CHAMPIONSHIPS 2023



- Tripura's Asmita Dey clinched gold medal in the Junior Asia Cup Judo Championships in Macau, China.
- In addition to her gold medal at the Junior Asian Judo Championships 2023 in Macau, China, she had secured a silver medal at the Asian Open 2023 held in Kuwait City in April of this year and a bronze medal at the Asian Junior Championships in 2022.



AUSTRIAN GRAND PRIX 2023



KEY POINTS

• Max Verstappen, the reigning Formula One champion, continued his impressive performance by securing a commanding victory at the Austrian Grand Prix 2023.

TORNEO DEL CENTERNARIO 2023



- Recently on 30th July, The Indian women's hockey team wins the title of Torneo del Centernario 2023 by defeating hosts Spain 3-0.
- The 100th anniversary Spanish Hockey Federation International tournament 2023 also known as Torneo del Centenario 2023 was held in Terrassa, Barcelona, Spain.
- Vandana Katariya, Monika and Udita scored vs Spain as the Indian women's hockey team finished the three-nation tournament with eight points from four matches.
- There were three teams Spain, India and England participated in the Tournament it held in the round robin format.





SUMMITS

CINEMATOGRAPH AMENDMENT BILL 2023



- The Minister of Union Information and Broadcasting, Anurag Thakur introduced the Cinematograph Amendment Bill 2023 in Rajya Sabha which aims to tackle film piracy.
- The landmark bill aims to comprehensively curb the menace of 'Piracy' causing losses of Rs 20,000 Crores to the film industry, based on certain estimates.
- The provisions include strict punishment of minimum 3 months imprisonment and fine of Rs. 3 lakes which can be extended up to 3 years imprisonment and fine upto 5% of the audited gross production cost.
- The new bill has also provisions to classify films on the basis of age group, instead of the current practice of 'U', 'A' or 'UA'. The amendment seek to add new classification- "UA-7+", UA-13+" and "UA-16+" in place of 12 years.
- According to a report by Ernest and Young the Indian film industry suffered a loss of about Rs.18k crore in 2019 due to piracy.
- To address this issue of piracy the Government of India has introduced the Cinematograph Amendment Bill 2023 in Rajya Sabha.
- The bill seeks to amend the Cinematograph Bill 1952, which regulates the certification and exhibition of films in India.





SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

INDIAN AIRFORCE 'TARANG SHAKTI' EXERCISE



- The Tarang Shakti exercise represents a crucial step by the Indian Air Force toward fostering cooperation and interoperability among nations.
- Meanwhile, concurrently, the Indian Navy is participating in the Malabar series of naval exercises, which are being conducted along the eastern coast of Australia.
- This exercise aims to enhance military cooperation and collaboration with air forces from 12 nations.





"JUPITER-3"



- Elon Musk-led SpaceX launched Hughes Jupiter 3 which is the largest private communications satellite using the Falcon Heavy launch vehicle.
- The Jupiter 3 satellite is designed to deliver internet services to customers in North and South America.
- The Jupiter 3 satellite features a new architecture based on a range of new technologies, including the miniaturisation of electronics, solid-state amplifiers and more efficient antenna designs.
- It will join Hughes' existing Jupiter satellite network, doubling its current capacity to 500 GBps.



INS KIRPAN



KEY POINTS

- Indian Naval Ship Kirpan has been Decommissioned from the Indian Navy and Handed Over to Vietnam People's Navy (VPN) at Cam Ranh, Vietnam.
- INS Kirpan, since commissioning in 1991, has been an integral part of the Indian Navy's Eastern Fleet and has participated in many operations over the last 32 years.
- Manned by about 12 officers and 100 sailors, the ship is 90 meters long and 10.45 meters in width with a maximum displacement of 1450 tons.
- The transfer of Kirpan to the Vietnam People's Navy resonates with India's G20 vision of Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam One Earth, One Family, One Future"

GAGANYAAN HUMAN SPACEFLIGHT MISSION



- ISRO successfully tested Gaganyaan Human Spaceflight Mission on 19th July at ISRO Propulsion Complex (IPRC) at Mahendragiri in Tamil Nadu.
- This test involved five liquid apogee motor (LAM) engines with a thrust of 440 N, and 16 reaction

control system (RCS) thrusters with a thrust of 100 N.

• It involves sending a crew of three members to a 400 km orbit for a three-day mission and bringing them back safely to Earth, with a planned landing in Indian Sea Waters.

SATELLITE NETWORK PORTAL SITE



- The Gujarat government signed an MoU in Gandhinagar with London-based Company, OneWeb and the Department of Science and Technology, Government of India for setting up a 'Satellite Network Portal Site.
- OneWeb Company is setting up two 'Satellite Network Portal Site' and one of them will be in Mehsana District of Gujarat.
- This Satellite network portal site is going to be initiated in Jotana taluka of Mehsana district.
- The satellite network portal to be established in Katosan and Tejura in Jotana Taluka of Mehsana district is scheduled to be launched in 2023 with an estimated cost of over Rs.100 crore for its Phase-1.



REPORTS

HEAT INDEX



- Indian Meteorological Department (IMD) started issuing heat index for different parts of the country on 21st July on an experimental basis.
- Heat Index is implemented on experimental basis across the entire country including the State of Andhra Pradesh.
- The experimental Heat Index has been launched by IMD to provide general guidance for the regions within India where, the apparent temperature/feel like temperature (considering the impact of humidity along with the temperature) are on the higher side causing discomfort for the people.
- heat index for Bhubaneshwar and Ahmedabad under Heat Action Plan is done under project mode by National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) in collaboration with local agencies like Indian Institute of Public Health (IIPH)
- At present, heat index is derived using the heat index equation similar to what is used by National Weather Service, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), USA.

QS BEST STUDENT CITIES 2024 RANKING



KEY POINTS

- Mumbai has ranked 118, the highest among Indian cities in the latest Quacquarelli Symonds (QS)
 Rankings for Best Student Cities 2024 released on July 19.
- At 132nd position, Delhi has come as the second most affordable student-friendly city followed by Bengaluru at 147, and Chennai at 154.
- QS has ranked cities on six parameters, including university rankings, student mix, desirability,
 employer activity, affordability and student voice, a press statement reveals.

HENLEY PASSPORT INDEX



- According to the Henley Passport Index, Singapore now holds the title of the world's most powerful passport, granting visa-free access to 192 out of 227 global travel destinations.
- Japan, which had held the number one position for five years, has dropped to third place due to a decrease in the number of destinations offering visa-free access to its passport holders.
- The Henley Passport Index 2023 assesses passports by the number of countries their owners can
 enter without a visa. It was published by Henley & Partners, a worldwide firm that provides advice



on citizenship and residence.

• The index relies on data from the International Air Transport Association (IATA), which has the most extensive and precise travel information database globally.

• India has made significant progress in the Henley Passport Index, improving its ranking by 5 spots compared to the previous year. It currently shares the 80th position on the index with Togo and Senegal.

- The release of the third edition of the Export Preparedness Index (EPI) by NITI Aayog aims to assess and improve the export performance of Indian states and UTs.
- The report presents a comprehensive analysis of India's export performance in FY22, along with its sector-specific and district-level merchandise export trends.
- The EPI 2022 Report evaluates the performance of the states across four pillars Policy, Business Ecosystem, Export Ecosystem, and Export Performance.
- The index uses 56 indicators which holistically capture the export preparedness of States and UTs in terms of exports at both the state and district-level.
- These pillars are further based on ten sub-pillars Export Promotion Policy; Institutional Framework; Business Environment; Infrastructure; Transport Connectivity; Export Infrastructure; Trade Support; R&D Infrastructure; Export Diversification; and Growth Orientation.

CHAIRPERSON OF IPCC



- On July 26 Jim Skea of the United Kingdom is the newly elected Chair of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC).
- With nearly forty years of climate science experience and expertise, Jim Skea will lead the IPCC through its seventh assessment cycle.
- The IPCC was created to provide policymakers with regular scientific assessments on climate change, its implications and potential future risks, as well as to put forward adaptation and mitigation options.

- International Tiger Day has been observed annually on July 29th since its inception in 2010 during the Saint Petersburg Tiger Summit.


WORLD DAY AGAINST TRAFFICKING IN PERSONS
